Had enough? Not Ben! He is the Chair of the Membership Committee of the Rondout Valley Business Association, formerly the Marbletown Business Association. He is vice chair of the Marbletown Historic Preservation Commission whose mission is the preservation of the exteriors of local historic homes.

This group is made up of a member of each of the official town governmental committees, the Planning Board, the Zoning Board of Appeals, the Town Board, the Town Supervisor and members of the public. Their function: to consider proposed new laws and work on the drafting or refining of them before they are submitted to the Town Board for public hearings and further

action.
